press relations officer (PR)	website editor

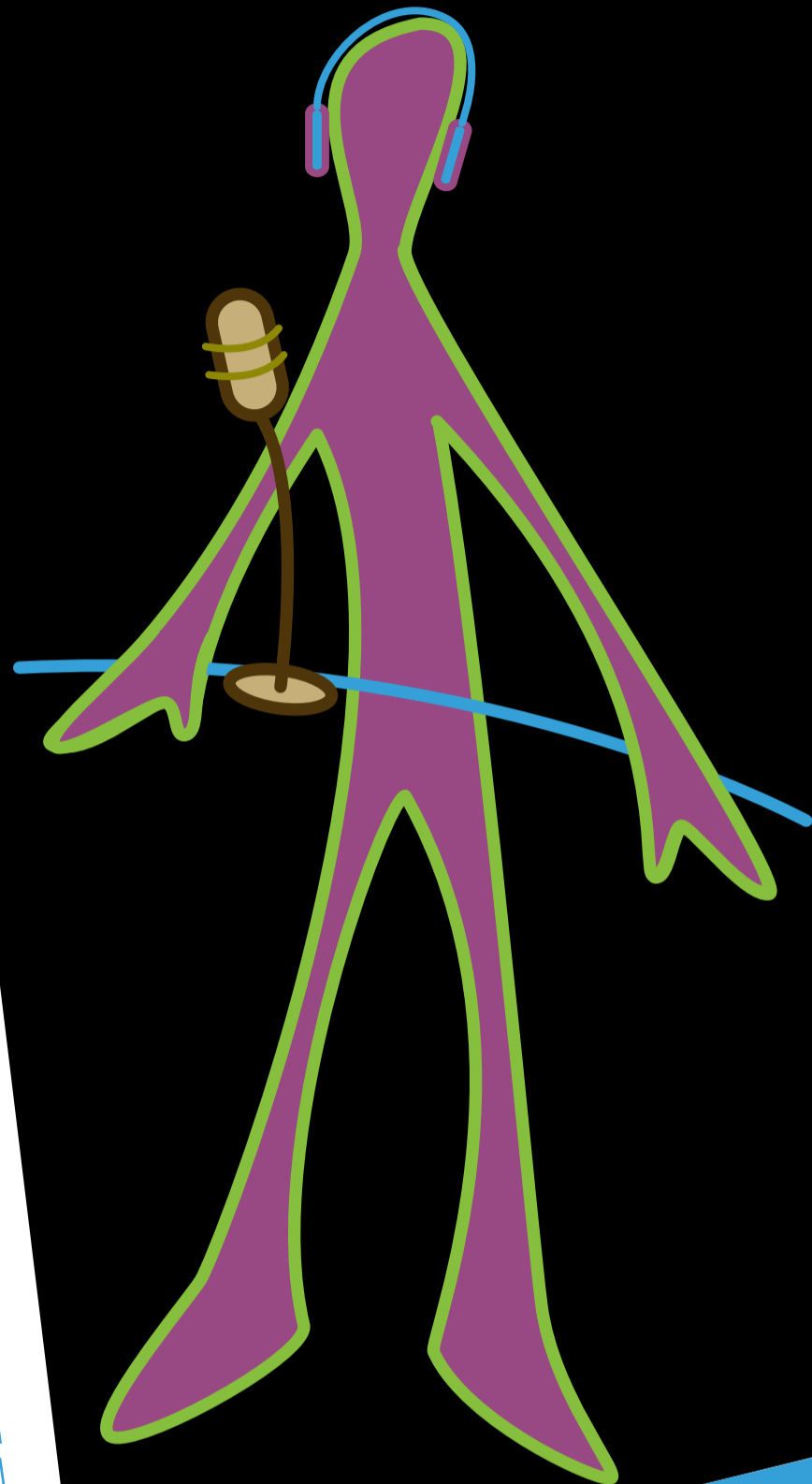
